

EXPECTATIONS AND GUIDELINES

- All Students **must** have their itineraries with them to be on time and participating in the proper activities
- School rules and expectations still apply at camp (including clothing)
- Clothing must be appropriate:
 - o No Short - shorts/skirts (Must come below finger tips)
 - o No spaghetti straps & No bra straps showing
 - o No inappropriate images/words on clothing (Vulgar/offensive)
 - o Warm Clothing **MUST** be worn outside during cold weather
 - o Those students who do not follow by these rules will need to change and/or stay in a chaperoned area (depending on situation)
 - o Indoor Slippers/shoes/socks **must** be worn indoors**Camp policy!
- No Peanuts/Tree Nuts allowed at camp (no exceptions)
- Electronic devices are not recommended
 - o Students take these items at their own risk.
- Respect others and yourself
- Participate to the best of your ability in all activities.
- ** Students not passing their academic subjects or who are behavior problems in music class or any class **will not** be permitted on our trip.

ZERO TOLERANCE IS GIVEN FOR THE FOLLOWING:

(Students will be sent home immediately: at parents own transportation expense)

- o No Drugs/Alcohol/Cigarettes
- o Damage made by students to any camp equipment, furniture or natural surroundings (Students will pay for and be sent home)
- o Rooming will change if there is a problem (if severe, sent home!)
- o No Leaving Camp Boundaries (supervised areas)
 - Students **always** need to be in buddies while outside
- o No visiting in other students' cabins
 - Please visit with friends in the common areas
- o Evening Lights out at 10pm. By 10:30 there is **ZERO** tolerance for noise (This is both a Camp and a school policy)
- o 1 warning is given for noise/bedtime rules, then students are moved/ sent home (depending on severity)
- o No pranks (to students/staff/teachers/chaperones/camp itself)
- Respect for outdoors and campsite (no damage, littering, etc.)
 - o Students are asked to leave things where they are, to recycle and to respect nature and the campsite area!
