### AIRPORT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Students to meet at 7:30 am at the Calgary International Airport (own transportation to airport)
- Please meet on the Ground Level, by the West Jet group check-in counter
- Parents/guardians please accompany your child to the meeting location and sign them in with their assigned chaperone (given out this Monday at student Conn3ct meeting).
- We ask that everyone ensures they are respectful of the check-in time, location & keeping a path clear for other passengers to walk in the hallway without us blocking the entire pathway.
- All students are responsible for their own luggage, instrument and/or assigned equipment!
- Students must have all their luggage/equipment labelled and tagged (tags to be provided on site)
- Once signed in with their chaperone, students must stay with their chaperone for all airport check-ins, meeting times, and boarding the plane. Thank you for being safe together.

#### **CLOTHING**

#### **PERSONAL HYGIENE**

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Deodorant! (please no perfume/body spray)
- Hair comb/brush
- Personal toiletries
- Any medication necessary  
\*We cannot give students medication. They must bring their own

#### **BAND EQUIPMENT**

- Instrument\*
- Sheet Music & folder \*
- Valve oil/slide grease\*\*
- Reeds\*\*
- Mallets\*\*
- Percussion equipment required\*\*
- Mouthpiece\*\*
- Instrument cleaning/care tools
- Pencils and erasers  
\*\*Depending on your instrument

#### **OTHER ITEMS TO CONSIDER:**

- School Homework and Study material
- Camera/phone (taken at your own risk)
- Bedtime reading material
- Extra Snacks
- Water bottle \*\* (must emptied at airport)
- Ear plugs (if needed)
- Extra money for lunches/shopping/snacks, etc.
- Towel for swimming

1. Students may find it helpful to bring a checklist of their belongings, so they can make sure they leave with everything they came with!
